Dr Hook Frontman Dennis Locorriere Has Died

After Long Battle With Kidney Disease

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USPA NEWS - Dennis Locorriere, the iconic frontman of Dr. Hook, has left an indelible mark on the music world, passing away at 76 after a brave fight against kidney disease, leaving behind a legacy of hits like When You're In Love With A Beautiful Woman, Sharing The Night Together, Sylvia's Mother, and Cover Of The Rolling Stone.
